GT RADIAL SHINES AT THE JAKARTA SUPERSPORT CHAMPIONSHIP IN ANCOL

The Ancol Jakarta Supersport Championship (AJSC) Series 1, which took place over the weekend of February 3-4, 2024, at the Ancol Circuit, North Jakarta, was a thrilling launch to the country's racing season for the year. The event, held at the Ancol Carnival Circuit, made history by hosting five motorsport disciplines simultaneously on one circuit, showcasing an unprecedented diversity in racing: slalom, drifting, motorbike freestyle, and drag racing for both cars and motorbikes.

GT Radial's team of drift racers brought their A-game to the drifting competitions, with notable performances that captured the audience's admiration. Among the stars was Ayuni,

a formidable female drifter who triumphed in two categories, earning 1st place in the Pro2 Class (Women) and securing a commendable 3rd place in the Pro2 Class (Men). Furthermore, GT Radial's own Billy Anjewa made his mark by achieving 3rd place in the Pro Class category. Notably, Billy Anjewa's car featured a new livery for 2024, staying true to his distinctive anime-themed aesthetic, underscoring GT Radial's commitment to style and performance. The Ancol Jakarta Supersport Championship not only set the pace for Indonesia's 2024 motorsport activities but also highlighted GT Radial's pivotal role in supporting and elevating the local racing scene.

Among the standout performers was Ayuni from VRS78, a drift academy sponsored by GT Radial, who clinched second place in the Women Drift Challenge Pro AM class. Additionally, Naufal Rafif Busro made his mark by securing third place in Round 2 of the Pro Class category.
